EAGLE COURT OF HONOR POLICY

Adopted January, 2005

1. Eagle Candidates may request a choice of guest speakers for the ceremony, and a choice of dignitaries or organizations to make presentations during the dinner hour, providing he has successfully completed his District Eagle Board of Review three (3) months in advance of the Court of Honor. The Troop Committee will vote to accept or reject the request of the boy at their meeting two (2) months prior to the Court of Honor. If this time frame is not possible, then the Troop Committee Chairman and the Scoutmaster will make the decisions, with advice from the Troop Committee, as time will permit.
2. All invitations to participate in the Court of Honor and dinner presentations will be sent by the Troop Committee Chairman or the Scoutmaster, with the full knowledge of the other, after being presented to the Troop Committee two (2) months in advance, when possible. Any necessary changes after the two (2) months lead time will have to be a command decision.
3. Guests of the Troop for the dinner will be honored guests, the Eagle Candidate, and those persons who have a part in the ceremony.
4. In the event of two (2) or more boys completing the rank of Eagle near the same time, one (1) Court of Honor will be held which will include all those boys.
